







## Anthony Poon, FAIA, NCARB, LEED GA

Educated as a multi-disciplinary designer, Anthony Poon is an award-winning architect, published author, classically-trained musician, and mixed-media artist. Spanning three decades of professional experience, Anthony is a LEED-accredited architect licensed in California, Virginia, and Montana, an IIDA interior designer, and has been elevated to the prestigious College of Fellows of the American Institute of Architects, the highest membership honor in the country. Mr. Poon received his Master of Architecture from Harvard University and his Bachelor of Arts from University of California, Berkeley, Magna Cum Laude. As a frequent public speaker, Anthony presents at national and regional conferences, as well as schools and universities. He is also a certified Feng Shui professional, and holds membership with the International Feng Shui Guild.

Mr. Poon was awarded—in an unprecedented two years in a row—the 2005 and 2006 National Grand Prize from Learning by Design, the highest honor given to an educational project in the country. In 2018, he received the top national award for residential design from the American Institute of Architects. Mr. Poon was also a concert pianist for the 2012 Architects in Concert, and an awarded artist for the 2013 and 2020 national Beverly Hills Art Show. His behind-the-scenes book, Sticks and Stones / Steel and Glass: One Architect's Journey has received critical acclaim, and his novel, Death by Design at Alcatraz explores the creative ego. In 2020, ORO Editions published internationally, Live Learn Eat: Architecture by Anthony Poon, edited by acclaimed architectural writer, Michael Webb.







Licensed in California, Montana, and Virginia, we have worked on over a hundred educational projects ranging from PreK-12 to universities, including the University of California and Los Angeles Unified School District. Poon Design's commercial projects have been with some of country's most prominent developers: Maguire, Thomas, Caruso, and Irvine Company.
